Bourgas airport (BOJ) <u>www.bourgas-airport.com</u> is located 10 km north of the city. There are numerous flights from all over Europe flying to Bourgas, especially in summer.

- International flights: WizzAir offers flights to London Luton airport, S7 to Moscow, Bulgaria Air and Bulgarian Air Charter to Tel Aviv.
- Seasonal flights: During the summer season, from May until September, charter companies offer flights from UK, Ireland, Czech Republic, Germany, Switzerland, Sweden, Norway, Poland, Hungary, etc. to Bourgas.
